Executive Message

The 2005/2006 school year has been a remarkable one for Children's Scholarship Fund Baltimore. Our parent organization, Children's Scholarship

Fund, Inc., renewed their commitment to match local funds for four more years. The Weinberg Foundation also renewed their matching challenge grant. In addition to this renewed support, on June 21st Children's Scholarship Fund Baltimore celebrated the first day of summer by inviting 75 special guests to learn more about the mission of CSFB and how they might be able to help. The event was hosted by long-time CSFB supporters John and Nancy Erickson aboard their yacht the "Andrea Cay." Soon afterward the number of donors contributing to CSFB increased by 25% and the average amount that individuals donated increased. After renewing scholarships to our current recipients and adding their siblings that reached school age, this year we were able to award 37 new scholarships. These children were chosen by lottery from our waiting list of over 2,100 families.

In September CSFB was awarded a Goldseker Foundation Management Assistance Grant. This will support research to assess scholarship recipients' academic level and implement an evaluation tracking procedure on an ongoing basis. Although not yet complete, the preliminary results of this project indicate outstanding academic performance by CSFB students, higher than our most optimistic expectations.

After this very successful year, Children's Scholarship Fund Baltimore is stronger than ever and plans to be helping children receive the quality education they deserve for many years to come.
